LIVE FROM AMELIA ISLAND

-  The Amelia Community Theatre puts on six main stage productions each season, as well as other shows and events on their studio stage.
-  The Amelia Musical Playhouse stages a variety of musicals, plays and revues throughout the year.
-  For more casual performances, enjoy live acoustic artists at several downtown eateries and bars, or catch a live band at The Green Turtle.
-  Tigre Island Room is a newly opened downtown Fernandina Beach venue offering jazz, folk, blues, indie, and roots performances in an intimate setting.
-  Bring a lawn chair and dancing shoes to the family-friendly Sounds on Centre outdoor concert series the first Friday of each month (Apr, Jun, Aug-Oct).

ASTOUNDING ARCHITECTURE

Amelia's turbulent and intriguing past under eight different flags of dominion can be seen in the architecture of historic downtown Fernandina Beach. Explore on your own or book one of several tours with the Amelia Island Museum of History. The Centre Street Tour, Gilded Age Tour, and Architectural Tour each showcase different styles and eras, from Classical Revival and Italianate styles to Queen Anne, Romanesque, and more.
